ALL ITEMS MUST BE CLEARLY NAMED WITH WOVEN NAME TAPES

Blazer	Regulation <u>with school buttons</u>
Skirt	Ripon Grammar School navy blue regulation skirt which has the school crest embroidered above the hem. The skirt must be worn below the knee
Tie	Regulation tie. Sixth form may wear "Sixth form tie". Boarders may wear "Boarding' tie"
White shirts	Long sleeves (during the summer term a short sleeved shirt may be worn with tie)
Tights	Opaque black tights
Shoes	Plain black, flat or with low, stout heel. Boots, trainers, suede, patent leather shoes or shoes with high/stiletto/kitten heels are not acceptable.
Coat	Warm and weather proof coat or anorak may be worn
DT/Art Apron	Compulsory years 1-3. Required if studying Art /DT at GCSE, AS and A2 level.
School bag	Must support the weight of books
Sweater (optional)	Dark navy-blue, long-sleeved, classic V-necked
Scarf (optional)	RGS school colours
School dress (summer term only)	Available from The Ripon Uniform Shop and Smart Start. If girls choose to wear the summer dress it must be worn with a school blazer, flesh coloured tights or white ankle or knee socks. The school dress should be worn at knee length/below the knee. The dress may also be worn with an adjustable navy blue belt. The belt is an optional item of uniform and can be purchased directly from school or from the school suppliers. Girls may opt to wear a dark navy blue school jumper in addition to their blazer in inclement weather. Cardigans are not permitted. <u>N.B.</u> If the girls choose to wear their winter uniform in summer, it must be <u>in full</u> , with the tie and black tights.

ALL ITEMS MUST BE CLEARLY NAMED WITH WOVEN NAME TAPES

Blazer	Regulation <u>with school buttons</u>
Trousers	Mid-grey, standard width bottoms without turn-ups. Black or charcoal grey trousers ARE NOT allowed. Skinny or drainpipe trousers are not permitted.
Tie	Regulation tie. Sixth form may wear "Sixth form tie". Boarders may wear "Boarding tie"
White shirts	Long sleeves (during the summer term a short sleeved shirt may be worn with tie)
Socks	Mid-grey
Shoes	Plain black. Please avoid deeply-ridged soles or heels which can hold dirt and mark floors. (Boots and trainers are not permitted).
Coat	Warm and weather proof coat or anorak may be worn
DT/Art Apron	Compulsory years 1-3. Required if studying Art /DT at GCSE, AS and A2 level.
School bag	Must support the weight of books
Jumper (optional)	Plain grey V-necked jumper, RGS gold/blue stripe on neck line
Scarf (optional)	RGS school colours
Vests (optional)	Must be plain white. No tee shirts with logos.
