As part of the KS4 pastoral curriculum students are required to explore the topic 'Risky Behaviour" to allow them to make informed, safe choices as they develop and mature into adulthood.

Citizenship is a compulsory requirement of the national curriculum and delivered through tutor time. The lessons are planned using national guidance as the framework and aims to help students develop an understanding of:

- diverse national, regional, religious and ethnic identities in the United Kingdom and the need for mutual respect and understanding.
- local, regional and international governance and the United Kingdom's relations with the rest of Europe, the Commonwealth, the United Nations and the wider world
- human rights and international law

On Friday 30th June, the Invisible Man Theatre, who work in partnership with North Yorkshire County Council, will be visiting Ripon Grammar School to perform a production of 'YOLO – You only live once', a play about taking risks without thinking, focusing on legal highs and sexting. This production will help to support and enhance their tutor time based learning.
