FRENCH EXCHANGE 2015-2016

Dear Parents and Pupils,

Following our successful visit to Charente-Maritime in October/ November 2015, the French pupils whom your sons/ daughters stayed with, are now looking forward to their visit to North Yorkshire. Here are some final details regarding the itinerary for the group's visit.

The group will arrive at 21:45-22:00 on Tuesday 22nd March 2016, and will depart at around 06:00 on Thursday 31st March 2016. Arrival and departure will take place at the Ripon Grammar School bus park.

On Wednesday 23rd March, the French pupils can be taken to school along with pupils, and they will accompany their partners in lessons. I have organised a timetable for the groups taught that day, which I have copied here. It is hoped that the experience of a day in a British school will be of cultural and educational value to the visiting pupils. During this day, it would be helpful if **Ripon Grammar School pupils could arrange lunch for their partners** in the dining room, either by buying it at the canteen or bringing in a packed lunch for them.

On **Thursday 24th March** (the last day of term) I have organised an excursion for the visiting group, who will spend the day in Ripon. Once again, if the visiting French pupils can be brought into school, and provided with a **packed lunch**, they will be ready to collect once the school day finishes at 15:55; RGS pupils will not accompany the group on this excursion.

Once term finishes on Thursday afternoon, it will be up to you, as hosts, to take care of the visitors and to make sure that they have a good experience. I will be in the local area for the duration of the visit, and I will be hosting the visiting group's teacher in charge, Madame Catherine Plisson, so if any problems arise we will be on hand to help. ITINERARY FOR FRENCH EXCHANGE VISIT, 22-31 March 2016

Tuesday 22 March: Arrival of group in Ripon c.21:45-22:00 at RGS bus park

Wednesday 23 March: French students to attend classes with their partners. See attached timetable.

Thursday 24th March: French students come into school with partners. RGS pupils have lessons as per usual.

09:30 – walking into Ripon 10:00-12:00 – visit and activities at the Ripon Workhouse Museum 12:00-13:00 – lunch (picnic) in Spa Gardens 13:00-14:00 – treasure hunt in Ripon town centre 14:00-15:00 – visit to Ripon Cathedral (to be confirmed) Return to Ripon Grammar School in time for departure of buses (15:55)
