RE: History Trip to Krakow and Auschwitz, Thurs 19th – Sunday 22nd Jan, 2018

Dear Parents and Guardians,

Thank you for allowing your son or daughter to take part in the History Department's trip to Krakow. As we approach departure, I thought it might be useful to provide further information to help students considering what to bring.

- Food: As mentioned in the initial letter describing the trip, all breakfasts and evening meals whilst we are in Poland will be provided as part of the trip cost. Students will therefore only need enough money to pay for their own meals whilst travelling and for inexpensive lunches in Krakow itself. Students need to make me aware of any dietary or allergy-related requirements not already outlined on their returned medical form as soon as possible.
- **Spending money:** Aside from that required to pay for food whilst travelling and during the two full days we are in Krakow, there will be no requirement to spend money whilst in Krakow as all excursions will be covered. There will, however, be some opportunities to purchase mementoes from the sites we are visiting and some limited time to explore shops in Krakow's famous "Old Town". Students are strongly advised to exchange pounds for Polish Zloty before the trip itself, with the Post Office generally offering far better exchange rates than those available from airport kiosks and no guaranteed time or place in our itinerary to exchange currency. I would estimate the equivalent of £40 to £50 spending money should be sufficient, given Poland generally lower cost of living.
- Luggage: Our flight is with Ryanair and includes 10kg hand luggage according to the requirements laid out on their website, plus one smaller bag for example handbag or small ruck sack. Please label all luggage clearly with your name and address in case of loss, and ensure that students alone can carry all of their luggage over long distances without help, as we will be walking a few hundred metres from the nearest coach park to our hotel.
- Clothing: Poland has experienced cold temperatures in recent weeks (reaching -5C just a few days ago the average temperature is 1C in January). It is therefore essential that students prepare for cold (and potentially wet) weather, anticipating long periods outside exploring largely open-air historical sites. A warm hat, multiple clothing layers, gloves and waterproof coat is crucial, as is sensible footwear with good tread. Towels will be provided by the hotel.

• **Essential documentation:** All students should hand their passport to a member of staff **upon boarding the coach** to Leeds Bradford Airport. Students will then be responsible for carrying their passports until we arrive in Poland when they will be collected in and held in the hotel safe. Students should ensure they carry their own European health Insurance Card on their person throughout the trip

Morning	After a continental breakfast in the hotel there will be a guided walking tour of Krakow's
	historic centre led by a local expert. Sites will include the wartime ghetto of Podgorze
	and Schindler's Factory (external view only), the Old Town Square, University District,
	Wawel Hill, and Kazimierz, the former Jewish Quarter.
Afternoon	Students free to buy lunch at one of the authentic Polish eateries followed by visit to the
	Schindler Factory Museum.
Evening	A three course evening meal accompanied by traditional live music in a Jewish
	restaurant in Krakow's historic Jewish quarter.
Saturday 20 January	
Morning	Depart hotel early (06:45am) to travel to Auschwitz by coach. An extended tour of
	Auschwitz I camp and Auschwitz II (Birkenau) camp will follow with one of Auschwitz
	Museum's expert guides.
Afternoon	Return to Krakow by coach. Some free time to rest or explore Krakow castle will follow
	prior to dinner.
Evening	Evening meal in the hotel followed by bowling in outer Krakow.
Sunday 22 January	·
Morning	A guided tour of the Galicia Museum on Jewish life and culture prior to the Holocaust
	will be followed by a meeting with a Holocaust concentration camp survivor or a relative
	of a survivor.
12:30 hrs	Time for a quick lunch in the Old Town before a return to the hotel.
15:20 (local time)	Check in at John Paul II Balice International Airport, for RYANAIR flight number FR 2333
21:00 (British time)	Scheduled time of arrival at Ripon Grammar School coach park.
