SECOND YEAR NORMANY TRIP 18th-23rd JULY 2015

Dear Parents,

This is a final letter prior to our departure to Normandy in a week's time. Firstly, I would like to confirm the departure and arrival times:

Depart from the Ripon Grammar School bus park at 01:00 on Saturday 18th July (please be there by 12:30 in order to load the bus)

Arrival back at the same place at 23:55 on Thursday 23rd July. I will use the phone chain established during the Parents' Information Evening to pass messages on regarding our exact arrival time, as it may change.

On the night of our departure, I will be standing with a head torch on, near to the back of the bus park, ready to collect medication if your son/ daughter has anything they need to take during the trip. It would be helpful if this were handed over in a sealed plastic bag with their name on. Any other items to be handed to me should also be clearly named.

The excursion programme remains unchanged from when I issued it at the Parents' Information Evening, but I include it below. Note that it includes Mr Auger's contact details, to be used in case of emergency only. It also includes different contact details for the bus company.

I now have passports, but there are still 19 pupils who have yet to give me their EHIC card. I will have told these pupils at our meeting on Friday 10th July. If your son or daughter was one of them, please can you send in an EHIC card with them as soon as possible.

Regarding packing, I have updated the list below. Note that all pupils need a towel and soap for their stay at the chateau since these are not provided by the chateau. I have also had questions relating to the fancy dress, asking about a theme. There is no group theme – the staff have a theme, but that's top secret!

Where and when

Please drop children off at school from 12:30am (middle of the night) in the early hours of Saturday 18th July. The buses will probably park in the bus turning area opposite the school's main entrance, so while it may be possible to park there, please park to allow the coaches free access.

We will be arriving back at the same place on Thursday 23rd July shortly before midnight. In order to ensure that we get everyone picked up at the right time, pupils with phones will call parents when we are en route.
