As part of the GCSE course, students study numerous aspects of health, communicable disease, pathogens and responses to disease. To enrich this aspect of the course, we are taking the Year 10 students to the Thackray Museum in Leeds for a talk and tour. This will be an excellent opportunity to explore how medicine and treatment has evolved and to ask questions of the experts of the Museum. To accommodate the entire year group we will split Year 10 into two groups with one group attending on the morning of Monday 5^{th} November (4A , 4B and the first half of half of 4C) and the second going on the morning of Tuesday 6^{th} November (the second half of 4C, 4D and 4E).

There will be a charge of £14 to cover the Museum and travel expenses. If this could be paid on ParentPay as soon as possible I would be hugely grateful as it helps us plan the trip much more effectively. The coach will leave at 8am on both days so students will need to be at school by 7.45am and should be in school uniform. Students will not require packed lunch as we be back at school for 12.15.
