## Re: buying an updated calculator for A level mathematics

The new A level has specific requirements such that your child's current calculator probably does not have enough capability to do all the necessary calculations that are needed. Therefore, I am writing to you to suggest you purchase a new calculator prior to the start of the new academic year in September.

Here is what the exam board specification states on calculator requirements: "It is expected that calculators available in the assessment will include the following features:

- an iterative function such as an ANS key,
- the ability to compute summary statistics and access probabilities from the binomial and normal distributions."

As you would expect there are lots of options available, but the department has experience of working with Casio models. Therefore, I recommend either the new *Casio fx-991CW Classwiz* or the model it has recently replaced, the *Casio fx-991EX Classwiz*. They cost about £25.

Given that many new A levels students will be looking to buy a calculator, I suggest the purchase is made sooner rather than later. Some high street shops may have one of the models, otherwise the internet provides a ready solution.
