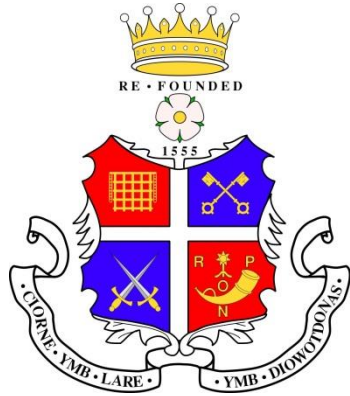



HOME-SCHOOL AGREEMENT

THE PARENT(S)/GUARDIAN(S) of(Name of Pupil)
