**You must select 3 A Level subjects and:**

1. the 'Plus One Programme'
- or**
2. AS Mathematics (this is the Mathematics options in the columns below, studied for one year).

In cases where a student wishes to be considered for a programme of four A Level subjects they should indicate this on the application form & give a brief explanation of the reasons why, this will then be assessed for suitability.

If the subject combination is unavailable, please discuss your choices with us as soon as possible and potential difficulties will be discussed on an individual basis. The timetable blocks have been drawn up after a survey of initial student preferences.
