A Level English Literature Trip to Haworth

We are studying Emily Brontë's *Wuthering Heights* as one of our two set prose texts for A level in English Literature. To enhance the pupils' understanding of the text and context, I have arranged a trip to the **Brontë Parsonage Museum** in Haworth on **Wednesday 15 November 2023**. There will be a specialist talk and tour, along with time to explore the village in small groups: previous visits have shown it to be of immense educational value.

We will travel by school minibus and will leave at **8.15am**, returning to school by **3.55pm** for the end of the school day. Pupils will need to bring a packed lunch, can wear their own clothes, and dress warmly.

The total voluntary contribution will be £16.50 to cover entrance to the museum and transport, and is payable via **ParentPay**; permission can be given on the same site, so there is no need to return a letter or reply slip. If insufficient contributions are received, the trip may be cancelled.
