If your child has not received their HPV vaccinations, you can still arrange this.

HPV is a common virus that can cause:

- Cervical cancer
- Some mouth and throat cancers
- Some anal and genital cancers
- Genital warts

Allowing your child to have the HPV vaccine will protect them against some of the diseases caused by the virus. You can still give consent for your child to receive this vaccine.
