A Level trip to the Centre for Life, Newcastle-Upon-Tyne

Dear Parent

As part of the theory and practical work involved with the biotechnology content of your son/daughter's biology course, and in order to provide a context for their studies as well as core practical skills, students will take part in a full day practical lab, "A Question of Taste". This is designed to practise the skills of PCR, cutting genes using restriction endonuclease enzymes and electrophoresis (all of which the theory will be covered in lessons before the trip). **The visit to the Life Lab at the Centre for Life in Newcastle city centre will take place on Thursday 15 December leaving school at 8.15am.**

This year we are also offering the opportunity for students to ice skate at the Centre for Life's Christmas skating rink after we have completed all lab work.

Parents are requested to provide consent for their son/daughter to attend the trip by paying a voluntary contribution of £37.90 using ParentPay no later than Monday, 12 December.
