Dear Parents, Friends, Old Riponians, Governors


No doubt you will be interested to hear how **our urgent Development Fund Appeal** is going - so here is your monthly update for July.

On 9 June the Chair of Governors and I wrote to all parents, governors and Old Riponians with an ambitious target of raising £150,000 per annum for the school. This was not only to meet the shortfall in voluntary contributions to fund key aspects of our co-curricular programme but also to raise money for essential developments across the school estate - given the fact all our discretionary funding for key estate works has been severely restricted.

A heartfelt thank you from all staff and students at RGS to all those parents and ORs who have generously responded - either by setting up regular monthly giving or through one-off donations.

Already the £30,000+ pledged means we can secure many of our sports fixtures next year by providing for sports transport and complete some of the key estate work. •	Library refurbishment	£20,000
•	2 new classrooms [urgent to move forms out of the science block]	£24,000
•	New PE Hub [with space for fitness suite]	£30,000
•	Science refurbishment	£30,000
•	Toilets refurbishment	£30,000
•	New tennis courts [currently unusable]	£70,000
•	New netball courts [currently unusable]	£70,000
•	New surface for the Astro [4 years left]	£250,000
