The Y7-8 Reading List has been updated and is attached with this issue of Owl Post.

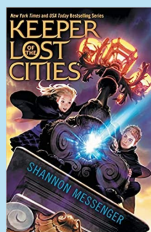
The reading list is also available through Accessit, our Library catalogue, which you can access in the following ways from home:

REMEMBER to **log on** in the top, right-hand corner where it says 'Guest', by selecting

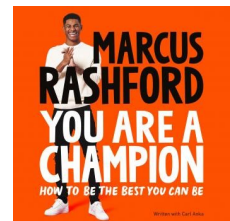
