Dear Parents

Over half term we completed some improvements to the main car park including re-marked bays, areas of designated parking and a new raised zebra crossing and speed ramps. May I therefore use this opportunity to remind parents of the following rules which are in place for the safety of staff and students.

General:

Up until 4:30pm each day, only members of staff are permitted to access the main drive and car park.

Students should not be driven onto the school site to be dropped off/picked up at any time before 4:30 p.m. This includes students delivered by taxi.

Parents should use Clothierholme Road for parking and students should use the footpaths to enter/exit the school site.

The following exemptions to these general points apply:

- Students who require special access due to physical need. Taxis/cars may use the two designated disabled parking bays in front of the Clocktower.
- Boarding parents may use the main car park/Johnson House parking to pick up and drop off boarders on Sunday evening [no time restriction], Monday morning [before 8:30am] and Friday evening [after 4:15 pm.] Please note Johnson House Drive is strictly closed to all vehicles between 8:30 am to 4:10 pm, Monday to Friday.
- Parents who are visitors with an appointment in school may access the drive and main carpark during the school day and park in the either of the two designated visitor parking bays in front of School House entrance.

For all using the Main and Johnson House Drives, drivers are requested to:

- Stop at the bottom of the drive before proceeding onto Clothierholme Road. Please use the mirror to sight pedestrians.
- Observe the 5mph limit at all times on the drive and in the car park.
- Proceed with caution over the two sleeping policemen and the raised zebra crossing – taking due regard for pedestrians using the zebra crossing.
- For those exiting the car park, give way to cars coming up the drive from Clothierholme Road by stopping at the give way point.
